Thank you for the detailed information that you provided on the Plan S10578 for increasing the ampacity of the 115 kV circuit Q6S from Cataraqui TS to Sidney TS.

We have reviewed the documentation submitted by you and concluded that the proposed upgrade modifications will improve the reliability of the IMO controlled grid by increasing the thermal capability of the 115 kV single circuit line Q6S.

Our review also concluded that a formal Connection Assessment study is not warranted.

The IMO is therefore pleased to grant approval to commence the line upgrade work. A copy of this Notification of Approval will also be provided to the Ontario Energy Board (OEB).

To commence the construction process, please follow the necessary procedures and obtain the required approvals, licences and permits as may be required by the OEB and other regulatory authorities.
