- Market participants identified need for greater clarity regarding the applicability of reliability standards obligations
 - More than one hundred reliability standards with multiple requirements
- Market rule amendment MR-00330 initiated to address market participants' concerns

- MR-00330 suggests changes to:
 - Obligate the IESO to identify to each market participant their Responsible Entity Designation(s) based on the NERC Reliability Functional Model;
 - Clarify reporting requirements and remove an inconsistency between the current market rules and certain reliability standards
 - Explicitly identify that the IESO's determination of each market participant's Responsible Entity Designation(s) is subject to dispute resolution process
 - Amend market rule definition of "NERC"

- Jan 16: Technical Panel (TP) determined market rule submission warrants consideration
- Mar 27: TP to consider market rule proposal and recommend posting for stakeholder comment
- Mar 29 – Apr 19: Proposed amendment posted for stakeholder comment (3 weeks)
- May 1: TP to consider stakeholder comments and make a recommendation to IESO Board
- Jun 28: Seek IESO Board approval
- Sep 12: Proposed effective date for MR-00330 if approved by IESO Board
